Elevators: Firefighters' Emergency Operation, Phase I Recall, and NFPA 72 Presented by Jim Runyan - L&I

This presentation will cover the codes that govern elevator emergency operation. When is recall required, where are detectors required, Fire Fighter's emergency operation, fire service access elevators vs public elevators, elevator entrance frames, and inspection & testing.

Jim Runyan is an Elevator Technical Specialist who works for WA Labor & Industries Elevator Safety Program. Jim has over 49 years' experience in the elevator industry. He is an instructor for NEIEP (National Elevator Industry Elevator Program), a member of NAESA (National Association of Elevator Safety Authorities), and a Member of several ASME code committees.

IFC 2018 §907 & NFPA 72 2013 vs 2016 Presented by Shane Clary, Bay Alarm

This presentation will cover IFC 2018 section 907 and the significant changes between the 2013 & 2016 edition of NFPA 72. The 2016 edition of NFPA 72 is scheduled to be adopted by the state along with IFC 2018 on February, 1st 2021 per the State Building Code Council. Whether AHJ, A&E, Designer, Installer, or Estimator this update will mean change. Come listen to Dr. Clary as he takes us thru the changes and helps us to understand their impacts.
